# Information for Prospective members

The British Association of Perinatal Medicine (BAPM) was founded in 1976 with the primary aim of improving the standard of perinatal care in the British Isles.

The membership, now over 800, includes obstetricians, paediatricians, nurses, midwives, nurse managers, pathologists, epidemiologists, radiologists, anaesthetists, geneticists, paediatric surgeons and others.

We welcome those involved in practice, teaching and research into any aspect of perinatal medicine and we encourage nurses, midwives and others contributing to the advancement of perinatal medicine to be nominated for membership. Close ties are maintained with other professional bodies concerned with the perinatal period and in particular with the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists, and the Royal College of Paediatrics and Child Health.

The Trustees, Executive Committee and Executive Officer direct the activities of BAPM which include setting standards of perinatal care and their audit, multicentre research (co-ordinated by the Perinatal Clinical Trials Group) and postgraduate training. At least two scientific meetings are organised each year as well as the Annual General Meeting which is open to all members. ## BAPM Subscription

### 1. UK Members

There is an annual subscription fee payable for membership of BAPM which is currently £100 per annum (medical members) and £50 per annum (non-medical members) payable by Direct Debit which is collected on 1 March each year.

### 2. Non-UK Members

If non-UK applicants hold a Current Account with a Bank in the UK, payment may be arranged by Direct Debit as above. If this is not the case, the annual subscription fee can be paid by bank draft in GBP (not local currency) or by credit card (tel: +44 (0) 20 7092 6085).
